Reporting to the Coreshack Supervisor, you will be part of the Production Geology Department. You will be responsible for processing and sampling/cutting diamond drill core. You will also ensure that goals and objectives are achieved while promoting and respecting Agnico Eagle's values, Health & Safety Code of Conduct, and the environment.

- Pickup drill core from headframe/drill site, open boxes and arrange in order;
- Checking for block footage error and proper labelling;
- Cut/Bag core as per training procedure including QA/QC samples;
- Complete lab analysis forms and deliver to various labs;
- Palletize/dump logged and sampled core boxes;

- Maintain good housekeeping at all times, ensure proper PPE and tools are used for all tasks;
- Operate forklift as per proper training, moving core skids with core or samples and other materials;
- Take part in storing pulps and rejects as required;
- Assist geologists as required.
