Reporting to the Surface Projects, Technical & Strategy Superintendent, you will be part of the Surface Operations Department. You will be responsible for overseeing Site Services at Macassa. You will ensure all work is planned and executed per the plan, ensuring workers are trained according to regulations and have the tools and direction to perform their jobs efficiently. You will also ensure that the goals and objectives are achieved while promoting and respecting Agnico Eagle's values, Health & Safety Code of Conduct and the environment.

- Align work with budget and considerations that support the mine with safety and costconscious awareness;
- Assist in the definition of project scope and objectives, involving all relevant stakeholders;
- Coordinate internal resources and third parties/vendors for the execution of projects;

- Track project performance, specifically to analyze the successful completion of short and long-term goals;
- Meet budgetary objectives and make adjustments based on financial analysis;
- Responsible and accountable for ensuring the reliability, operability, and maintenance of defined assets and equipment;
- Responsible for managing the coordinated work and establishing priorities with personnel to ensure minimal interruptions to the operation;
