- Systems Management: Motorola Radio Manager, Becker Varis SmartCom.
- Repair, install, configure and maintain LTE telecommunication installations such as: Nokia/Ericsson Private LTE, Ambra Solutions Private LTE;
- Repair, Install and maintenance of Fiber Optic installations including QA/QC;
- Wi-Fi based systems such as: TeleOperation, Cisco, Ubiquity, Rajant;
- Management of Local Area Network (LAN) Cisco based, Layer 3 design;
- Manage Innovation, Science and Economic Development (ISED) Canada (formerly Industry Canada (IC)) licenses within the region;
